President's Column

Happy Spring (almost) to everyone! The new season ushers in the field trip season, which has started, and which has some major changes compared with previous years. Until now we've enjoyed opportunities to hunt for fossils in the Martin Marietta (MM) quarries by having our club liaisons (David Sanderson for Castle Hayne, Don Rideout for Belgrade, Linda McCall for Onslow, and Linda or Don for Clarks) arrange for club trips into the quarries. Because of MM's new policies, in general we are not being allowed to have club trips anymore, just open quarry days. However, for what we thought might be giant free-for-alls in those open quarry days, different quarries have made caps on the numbers of people (from anywhere --- not just our club) who may attend. They are also working out ways to sign up for these trips. It can be very confusing. Please remember that the situation is still in flux and a little patience and politeness need to be the order of the day. Venting one's frustrations improperly to either trip liaisons or quarry managers or anyone else will not be helpful and could get you banned from future trips.

As it stands, a number of trips have been offered in the various MM quarries, but even they do not have universal policies. Our club was offered two Castle Hayne club trips through June, but we weren't offered the open quarry days which had not been decided when we got the club trips. If you would like to see the roster of all trips as we know them right now (and which change), please visit the Members Only page of the website and click on the link to see the spreadsheet of trips.

Hanson is the company that owns the quarry we visit in Rocky Mount, and it's policies are different from MM's. Linda is our liaison for that quarry. We have two spring trips there.

Besides the quarries, we do have a number of other collecting opportunities! We are actually very lucky to have so many areas to collect, but we are a large club with very enthusiastic members. We are trying our best to figure out ways to give as many opportunities to as many members as possible, while also honoring some priority for the Board and trip leaders. Our other trips are the Tar River (Rick Trone), Greens Mill Run (Rick), Old Dock (Linda), and Jacob's Creek Quarry (Ruffin Tucker).

Please exercise your patience while all of the kinks get worked out with trip announcements, sign ups, and notifications! We owe a big debt of gratitude to our quarry liaisons and trip leaders on all of our trips! Remember, too, to review our club's Code of Ethics, viewable on the website under Members Only.

Anyone not having all of these will be denied admission. Arrive prior to 8:30 to watch a short training video. Note that the two Clark's Quarry events, even though Open events, are already Full.

Update on Outreach

The board of directors has created a new position to help facilitate outreach requests. The new position is called the "Outreach Coordinator". The position is currently being filled by Julie Niederkorn. The club would like to keep track of all the wonderful outreach that our club members do each year.

The typical process is as follows:

- The club receives a request from a teacher, scout leader, museum, etc.
- The request is then sent out to the entire membership by the Outreach Coordinator.
- If someone is able to help out, they are asked to respond directly to the requestor, (teacher, scout leader, etc.).
- Once the member is able to schedule an event, they should notify the Outreach Coordinator to let them know that the request is being filled.†
- After the event, the member should fill out an Outreach Form, (please see below).
- Send any pictures and short stories to the Outreach Coordinator to be posted on the Facebook page and/or *Janus* newsletter, (please keep in mind that we may not be able to publish some photos without permission).

Outreach Form

The club has created a new Outreach Form that can be filled in online, or sent to the Outreach Coordinator via email or even snail mail if you prefer. This form is to be completed by the volunteer after the event. You can find a pdf file of the form for email or snail mail on the website. There are instances where a member will get a direct request to do an event and they are able to set it up directly with the requestor. That member can just fill out the form when they are done, no need to contact the Outreach Coordinator. → → →

† This will be helpful if a member wants to volunteer, they can check in with the Outreach Coordinator to see if the request has already been filled and/or if they need more than one person. Also, members can find out who all is signed up for an event where multiple members may be attending. This would be helpful for carpooling and also to coordinate displays.

NORTH CAROLINA FOSSIL CLUB CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Please conduct yourselves in a manner that best represents the NCFC.
2. Please make a sincere effort to keep informed of all laws, regulations and rules regarding collecting on private and public lands.
3. Never use the name of the Club to gain access to lands, or scientific sites actively under study by paleontological professionals for personal gain or profit.
4. Please act responsibly and safely on all club outings so as not to bring other members or yourself into harm or danger. Parents are responsible for their children and making sure their children follow all quarry, etc., rules. Firearms are prohibited from all Club functions.
5. Always respect and cooperate with the field trip leader or designated authorities in collecting areas. Do not bring along anyone not signed up for the trip, or any nonmember to a trip without clearing it with the field-trip leader first.
6. Never collect a site immediately prior to a scheduled field trip thereby preventing fair collecting opportunities for the rest of the members of the Club. "Scouting" ahead of time by the field trip leader is fine.
7. You are encouraged to contact the appropriate professionals upon discovery of what you consider to be scientifically significant fossils. This includes excavation, preparation, and documentation of the fossils in question. You are encouraged to consider donating such fossils to appropriate facilities.

→ → → Events like the Fossil Fair, Aurora Fossil Festival, Dino Days, are typically headed by one main person. That person will fill out one report for the entire group.
