The Smithsonian's shark tooth identification poster (just published) will be for sale to NCFC members at TG trips this spring. Cost is just \$5.00; the club has absorbed handling charges.

This large poster shows over 150 photographs, with notes explaining the classification of common invertebrate phyla, their classes and orders, and diagrams illustrating some of the more usual morphological terms; also stratigraphic ranges of the commoner classes and orders.
